# New Committees

The TJCSGA Executive Board is proud to announce the creation of *three* new convention planning committees that will give Regions more input in planning the convention. The *Historian Committee* was also created to help gather pictures and video throughout TJCSGA. Below is a brief description of these committees.

The *Registration Committee* Members will be charged with helping pass along registration and other important Convention information along to their respective regions. The committee members will be the Region Secretaries. The chair will be the TJCSGA Host and the vice-chair will be the TJCSGA Treasurer.

The *Standing Rules Committee* Members will be charged with developing a set of standard rules for the convention. The committee members will be the Region Parliamentarians. The chair will be the TJCSGA Parliamentarian.

The *Programming Committee* Members will be charged with working with the TJCSGA Executive Board on developing the program the convention. The committee members will be the Region Hosts or other member as designated by the Region President whose duties relate to those of this committee. The chair will be the TJCSGA Vice President.

The *Historian Committee* Members will gather photos, articles, and video from their respective regions to include in the bulletins and to create a digital scrapbook at the Convention. Each Region President will appoint at least *one* member for this committee but no more than *three*. Any TJCSGA delegate can serve on this committee. The chair of this committee shall be the TJCSGA Editor of the Bulletin.

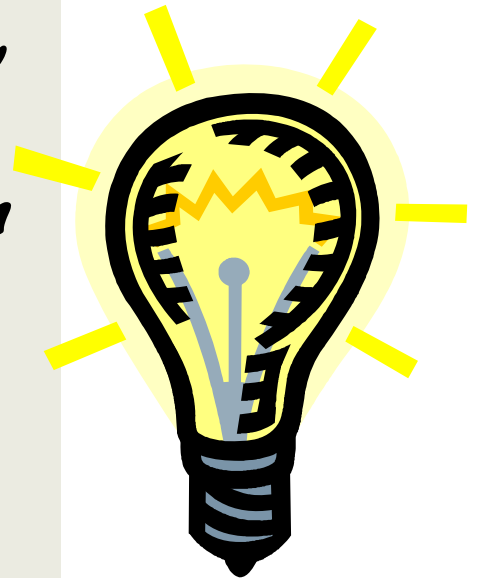
