



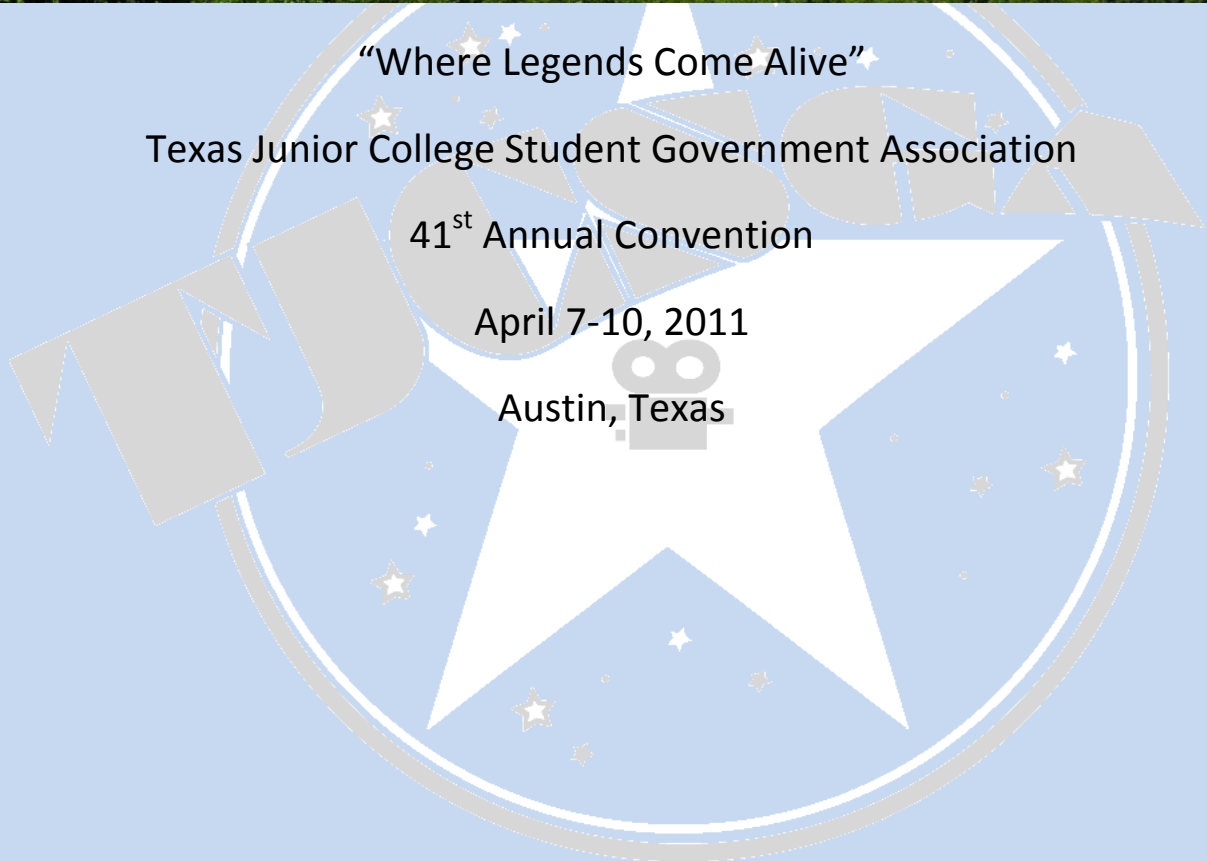

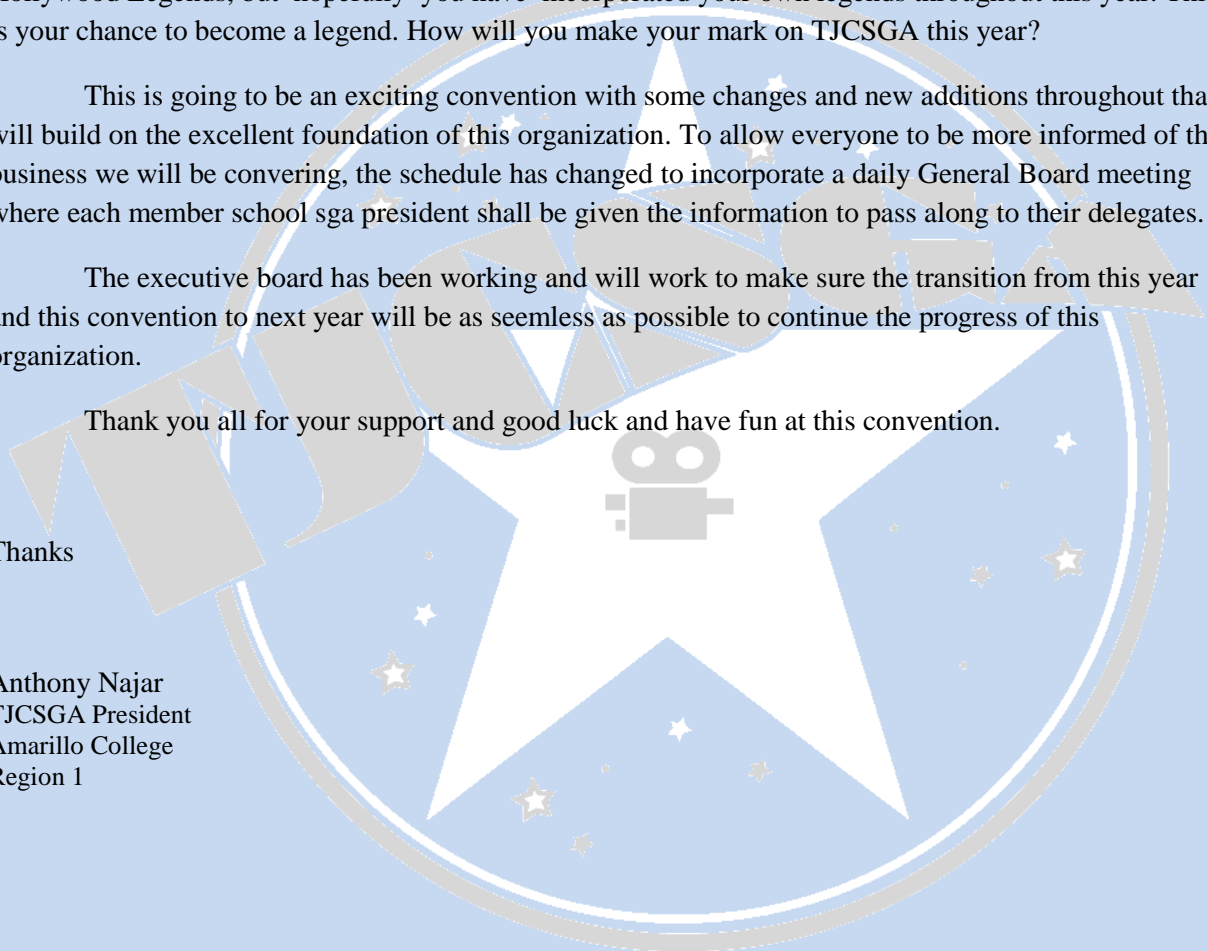

## Christopher Williams

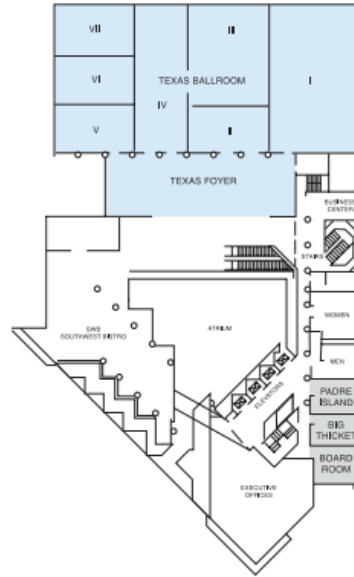
