TEXAS JUNIOR COLLEGE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION
RESOLUTION FROM TJCSGA REGION II
AS AMENDED BY THE TJCSGA RESOLUTIONS COMMITTEE

A Resolution Concerning providing information on the geographic locations of all member colleges.

WHEREAS, the State Executive Board currently has the authority to allocate member colleges to a region of TJCSGA; and

WHEREAS, there is concern over the lack of knowledge of which colleges are assigned to each region; and

WHEREAS, there is potential to have an increase in members within TJCSGA from accredited colleges which are not current members that would require further changes to the existing geographic boundaries;

RESOLVED by the Texas Junior College Student Government Association in convention assembled, that the TJCSGA State Executive Board update the regional map outlining the current allocation of member colleges assigned to each region and that this be published on the TJCSGA website within ninety (90) days,

FURTHER RESOLVED, that a committee be established comprising of two member schools from each region to review the existing allocation of member schools to regions, and submit a proposal for consideration to a General Board Meeting within six (6) months that could establish a more defined geographic map inclusive of all accredited colleges within the State of Texas.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the boundaries of the geographic maps only be redrawn when there is a 5% change in the number of accredited schools within the State.
