Because of the COVID-19 Pandemic, I was able to enact the force majeure clause in the contract and cancel our contract with the hotel, without any financial burden to the organization. Once the hotel cancels our event, it will also cancel all room reservations made, by member schools and send a confirmation email to the person who made the reservation. You may also be wondering about refunds, state dues will not be refunded, since we plan to hold elections member schools need to have paid them to vote.
